Student Criteria:

- One nomination per institution
- Student must be a current student at the institution
- Student should show exceptional leadership in service to their community and institution

Please include the following:

- Signed letter from the Student Government Association or equivalent at the institution showing their support for the selection of the student
- Letter from a beneficiary of the service project explaining in 250 words or less how the service project impacted them
- Letter from the student nominated explaining in 250 words or less how they feel the service project has impacted their school, community, and their own life
- Letter from the Dean of Students, equivalent, or President of the institution showing their support for the selection of the student
