SUMMARY: This report highlights enrollment data submitted by the State's postsecondary institutions (final fall numbers, collected later in the term, usually vary slightly).

Total headcount enrollment at Maryland's colleges and universities increased by 5.2 percent, or 17,641 students, to a record high of 354,848. Over the past 20 years, total postsecondary enrollments in Maryland have increased by 39 percent, or over 100,000 students. For 13 straight years, total headcount enrollment has increased.

This year, enrollment increases were largest at the community colleges which accounted for more than two-thirds (67.7 percent) of the growth in postsecondary education. Public four-year campuses and independent institutions accounted for 3.0 percent and 25.8 percent, respectively, of statewide postsecondary enrollment growth.

SUBJECT: 2009 Opening Fall Enrollment

This report highlights preliminary fall 2009 enrollment data submitted by the State's colleges and universities.

Total headcount enrollment at Maryland's colleges and universities increased by 5.2 percent from last year to 354,848 – once again setting a record high. Total headcount enrollments have risen at Maryland colleges and universities for 13 consecutive years.

The community colleges increased their enrollment rates by 9.3 percent, more than any other segment, and accounted for more than two-thirds (67.7 percent) of the statewide postsecondary enrollment growth. Total enrollment at Maryland's public four-year colleges and universities increased by 3.0 percent, while enrollment at the independent colleges and universities increased by 2.0 percent.

Full-time undergraduate enrollments increased statewide by 5.8 percent to 165,334 students, marking the 16th consecutive year of such increases. All sectors increased their number of full-time undergraduates, but with a 13.3 percent increase, community colleges experienced the highest rate of growth.

First-time, full-time undergraduate headcounts increased by 1.9 percent to 40,542. This increase indicates a change from the two previous *Opening Fall Enrollment* reports, which cited decreases in the number of new full-time undergraduates attending Maryland colleges and universities. The part-time undergraduate headcount increased 5.7 percent.

Full-time graduate and professional enrollments increased by 4.75 percent, compared to an increase of 2.1 percent for part-time enrollments.

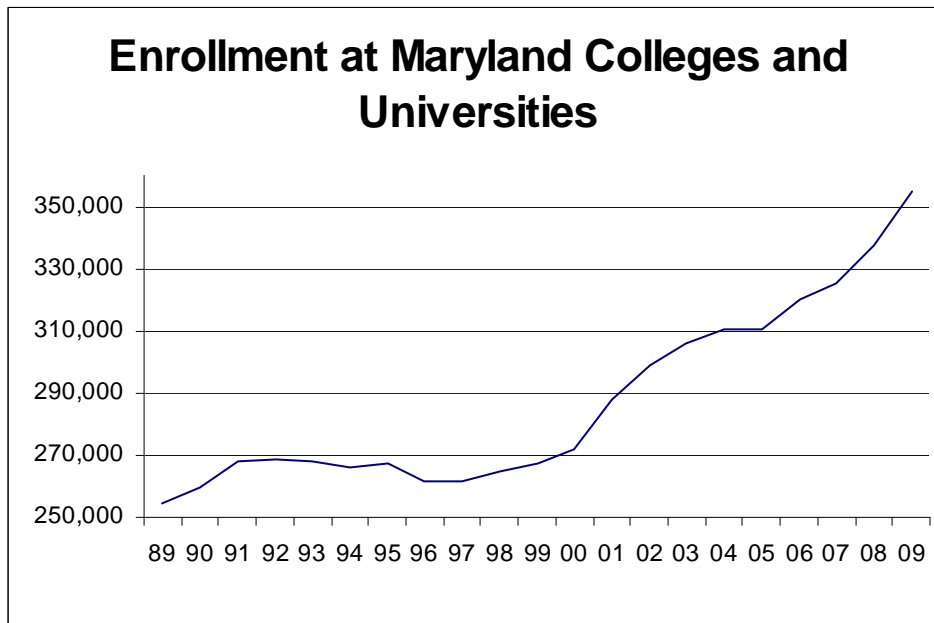

Enrollments Soar at Maryland Colleges and Universities – New Record Set

The following report highlights preliminary enrollment data submitted for fall 2009 by the State's colleges and universities. Final numbers may vary slightly due to students enrolling or deciding not to attend by November 15, the date by which final 2009 enrollment figures are reported to the Maryland Higher Education Commission



- Total headcount enrollment at Maryland's colleges and universities increased by 5.2 percent since last year, a gain of 17,641 students. This year's total headcount of 354,848 students sets a new record high for postsecondary enrollments.
- During the past 20 years, total enrollment in Maryland's degree-granting postsecondary institutions has grown by 39 percent, or over 100,000 students. For 13 straight years, total headcount enrollment has increased.
- Maryland community colleges experienced the greatest percentile gains of any higher education sector. Total enrollment at the community colleges increased by 9.3 percent (11,938 students) and accounted for more than two-thirds (67.7 percent) of the growth in postsecondary

enrollments. Last year, the community colleges were responsible for less than half (46.4 percent) of the year-to-year postsecondary enrollment gains. Compared to enrollment increases at the community colleges, growth at the public four-year campuses was more modest and totaled 3.0 percent, or 4,554 students. This sector accounted for just over one-quarter (25.8 percent) of the State's postsecondary enrollment growth, compared to last year when it was responsible for more than half (52.3 percent) of all statewide enrollment increases. Enrollments at independent colleges and universities increased by 2.0 percent (1149 students), compared to gains of only 0.2 percent last year, and were responsible for 6.5 percent of the State's enrollment growth.

- Total enrollment for the University System of Maryland increased by 3.0 percent (4,554 students) to 152,527. Enrollments at Morgan State University increased by 3.2 percent (221 students), while five fewer students enrolled at St. Mary's College of Maryland this year resulting in an enrollment decrease of 0.2 percent.
- Full-time undergraduate enrollment in the State's colleges and universities increased by 5.8 percent to 165,334 students (establishing another record high), and was responsible for more than half (51.4 percent) of the total (undergraduate and graduate) enrollment growth. Full-time undergraduate enrollments increased in all sectors, but with a 13.3 percent increase, community colleges experienced the highest rate of growth. The statewide number of full-time undergraduates has increased for 15 consecutive years, and has grown by 45 percent during that time.
- The part-time undergraduate headcount increased by 5.7 percent since last year, growing by 6,493 students. This increase was primarily the result of growth in part-time students attending Maryland's community colleges. Over the last year, the number of part-time students enrolled in this sector increased by 7 percent (5,622 students). The number of part-time undergraduates also increased at more modest rates at the University System of Maryland (2.2 percent, 633 students), and at the State's independent colleges and universities (6.6 percent, 260 students). However, Morgan State University and St. Mary's College of Maryland experienced decreases in their part-time undergraduate enrollments.
- Statewide, first-time, full-time undergraduate headcounts increased by 1.9 percent, from 39,787 in fall 2008 to 40,542 in fall 2009. This marks a change from the two previous opening fall enrollment reports which cited decreases in the number of new full-time undergraduates enrolled at Maryland campuses. There was a substantial increase in the number of first-time, full-time students attending community colleges (10.6 percent), and a decrease in the number of these students attending public four-year institutions (- 3 percent), and independent colleges and universities (-6.3 percent).
- Full- and part-time graduate and professional enrollments once again set record highs. The number of full-time graduate students enrolled increased by 4.7 percent to 26,620, while part-time students increased by 2.1 percent to 42,400.
- All of the community colleges except Allegany College of Maryland experienced overall enrollment gains. The Community Colleges of Baltimore County grew by the largest *number* of students (2,911), and also increased by the highest percentage of students (14.1 percent).
- Total enrollment (undergraduate and graduate combined) also increased at 11 of the 13 public four-year colleges and universities. Once again, enrollments at the University of Maryland University College increased by the largest number of students (2,294), and the University of Baltimore experienced the greatest percentage increase in enrollments (7.2 percent). Enrollments at Coppin State University and St. Mary's College of Maryland declined.

- Total headcount enrollments decreased at 16 of the 29 independent colleges and universities. Johns Hopkins University added 624 students and experienced the largest numerical gain, while ITT Technical Institute experienced the greatest percentage increase (49.6 percent) in enrollments.
- Women continue to outnumber men in all segments of Maryland's colleges and universities, and represent 58.1 percent of all students enrolled. However, this year, the enrollment increases for men out paced similar increases for women (5.9 percent vs. 4.7 percent).
