#### **SECTION A – Instructions:**

Maryland law requires that a student be enrolled for at least 12 credits each semester in order to receive a **2+2 Transfer Scholarship**. You may be eligible to appeal this requirement and receive an award if you are enrolled for less than 12 credits and you are enrolled in a specific course or activity (e.g. internship, practicum, clinical) that:

- o Is required by the institution to complete your academic program; and
- o Results in your being enrolled for less than 12 credit hours per semester; and
- o Is equal to or greater than 180 hours of actual time spent in the classroom, lab, or clinic.

# Appeals will NOT be considered for: convenience; hardship; or because only a certain number of courses are needed to complete degree requirements.

If your appeal is approved, your award will be recalculated based on your part-time status. A student enrolled for 9-11 credits will receive three-quarters of the award. A student enrolled in 6-8 credits will receive one-half of the award. A student with five (5) or less credits is not eligible for a grant. Audited courses cannot be used to attain minimum hours required for full-time status.

You <u>MUST</u> submit a separate appeal form for each semester in which you are enrolled for less than 12 credits. You <u>MUST</u> provide documentation that includes:

- Documentation of the courses and credits you are taking for the semester appealed (i.e. class schedule); and
- A copy of the program curriculum from the institution's catalog or from the institution's website.

Appeals and supporting documentation must be received no later than October 15, 2020 if appealing for the Fall 2020 semester and March 15, 2021 if appealing for the Spring 2021 semester.
