- 4. Receive a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent;
- 5. Be less than 22 years old at the time of the first scholarship award; and
- 6. Maintain satisfactory academic progress in accordance with the standards of the institution he/she is attending;

Award Amount: GEAR UP Scholarship awards are up to \$8,000 for fall and spring 2022-2023. Additional awards are available for students to attend summer school. The award is determined after all federal, state, and other relevant financial aid is determined. The scholarship award is prorated for students attending school less than full-time.

Scholarship Renewal: Students must apply every year. Awards are made for one year and may be renewed if the student maintains eligibility.
