CHARLES W. RILEY FIREFIGHTER & AMBULANCE & RESCUE SQUAD MEMBER SCHOLARSHIP

Must complete the FAFSA and application via MDCAPS by March 1st

Award Amount - Varies

Only actively engaged career or volunteer firefighters and EMT workers in Maryland may apply

JANET L. HOFFMAN LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM

Must complete the FAFSA by March 1st

Award Amount - up to \$10,000

Provides assistance for repayment of loan debt to select individuals employed full-time in nonprofit organizations and State or local government in Maryland

JOHN R. JUSTICE STUDENT LOAN REPAYMENT PLAN

Must complete application online via MDCAPS

Award Amount - Varies

Any person employed in Maryland as a full-time federal or state public defender or a State or municipal prosecutor (federal prosecutors are not eligible), involved in any phase of juvenile or adult criminal prosecution or defense

LOAN ASSISTANCE PROGRAM - DENTISTS

Must complete application via MDCAPS

Award Amount - up to \$23,740

Provides assistance for repayment of loan debt to dentists working with under-served populations in Maryland

MARYLAND LOAN ASSISTANCE REPAYMENT PROGRAM PHYSICIANS/MEDICAL RESIDENTS

Must complete application via MDCAPS.

Award Amount - up to \$30,000

Provides assistance for repayment of loan debt to physicians and medical residents specializing in primary care in under-served populations in Maryland

RICHARD W. COLLINS III LEADERSHIP WITH HONOR SCHOLARSHIP

Must complete the FAFSA /MSFAA by July 15

Complete online application available on MDCAPS

Submit all documentation by deadline

Award Amount - up to \$1,000

A ROTC member who is a minority student or a student of another group historically underrepresented students enrolled full-time at the following institutions only: Bowie State University, Coppin State University, Morgan State University, or University of Maryland Eastern Shore;

CYBERSECURITY PUBLIC SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

Complete online application available on MDCAPS by January 31

Submit all documentation by deadline

Award Amount - Varies

Enrolled full-time at a public or a private non-profit institution in the State in an approved credit-bearing degree or an approved credit- bearing certificate program

TEACHING FELLOWS SCHOLARSHIP

Complete online application available on MDCAPS

Submit all documentation by deadline

Award Amount - Varies

Enroll or plan to enroll at an eligible institution as an undergraduate or graduate student or seek to change careers to pursue a course of study or program in an academic discipline leading to a Maryland professional teacher's certificate.

NEAR COMPLETER GRANT

Contact previous attended college or university

Award Amount - Varies

Attended a two-year or four-year educational institution and completed college credits but does not have a college degree and is no longer attending an institution of higher education.

Completed 45 credits (two-year) or 90 credits (four-year).

Minimum GPA 2.0

All careers and occupations are eligible.

MARYLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP (MCCPS)

Must complete the FAFSA or MSFAA by March 1st

Award Amount - up to \$5,000

Students must ALSO submit ALL documentation if required

GUARANTEED ACCESS GRANT

Must complete the FAFSA or MSFAA by March 1st

Must complete additional applications online on MDCAPS

Award Amount - up to \$18,600

Open to High School Seniors who enroll full-time at a Maryland two- or four- year college or university

EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE GRANT

Must complete the FAFSA or MSFAA by March 1st

Award Amount - up to \$3,000

Open to new and current undergraduates who will enroll full-time at Maryland two- or four- year college or university

PART TIME GRANT

Must complete the FAFSA or MSFAA

Award Amount - up to \$2,000

Must be a part-time, degree seeking undergraduate student or a dually enrolled students at an eligible Maryland institution.

2 + 2 TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP

Must complete the FAFSA by March 1st

Award Amount - up to \$2,000

Open to current undergraduate students at a Maryland community college who will graduate with an associate's degree and are accepted for admission in a degree program at a Maryland public or private college or university

EDWARD T. CONROY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Must contact Institution's Financial Aid Office

Award Amount - up to \$11,530

Provides assistance to 100% disabled public service employees, children & spouses of deceased and 100% disabled military and spouses and children of victims of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks

JEAN B. CRYOR SCHOLARSHIP

Must contact Institution's Financial Aid Office

Award Amount - up to \$11,530

Provides assistance to 100% disabled employees of a public or nonpublic school in the State, children & spouses of deceased and 100% disabled employees of a public or nonpublic school in the State and spouses and children of victims of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks

VETERANS OF THE AFGHANISTAN AND IRAQ CONFLICTS SCHOLARSHIP

Must complete application online via MDCAPS

Award Amount - up to \$7,029

Veterans who served in the Afghanistan or Iraq Conflicts, and their spouses, sons, or daughters and is a full-time or part-time, degree-seeking undergraduate student enrolled in an eligible accredited Maryland postsecondary institution. FAFSA and application due by March 1st

TUITION WAIVER FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Must complete application online via MDCAPS

Award Amount - Varies

Provides assistance for repayment of loan debt to physicians and medical residents specializing in primary care in under-served populations in Maryland

TUITION WAIVER FOR UNACCOMPANIED HOMELESS YOUTH

Must complete the FAFSA & the institution's financial aid office

Award Amount - Varies

Provides assistance for unaccompanied homeless youth in Maryland at the time of high school graduation or completion of a GED

TUITION WAIVER FOR FOSTER CARE STUDENTS

Must complete the FAFSA & Maryland Department of Human Services

Award Amount - Varies

Provides assistance for out-of home placed students in Maryland at the time of high school graduation or completion of a GED
