Accepted Sources of Credit:

Elective and Required credit are available for the following:

- ACE Non-Collegiate Courses
- Advanced Placement (AP)* – minimum score of 3
- CLEP* – minimum score of 50
- DANTES*
- International Baccalaureate (IB) – minimum score of 3
- Military Credit*
- Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education Diploma Program – minimum score
