Appeal Criteria / Required Documentation **2025-26** Academic Year

The Maryland Higher Education Commission understands that students may experience circumstances that result in them failing to meet certain requirements for consideration or reinstatement of State grant and scholarship programs. Therefore, the Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA) has developed an appeal process for certain allowable programs and circumstances that allows students to request (re)consideration of a State award

Appeal Process

- 1. Students determine if they meet the criteria to submit an appeal based off the program and allowable appeals under that program.
- Student gathers all required documentation for the appeal.
- 3. Student completes the 2025-26 MHEC Grant and Scholarship Appeal Request Form, uploading all required documentation, by the published deadline.
- OSFA staff will review the appeal and make a determination within 45 business days, unless the student is informed otherwise.

Important Reminders

- Appeals must be submitted through the Appeal Request Form and will not be accepted by any other means.
- It is the student's responsibility to ensure they have provided all required documentation for their appeal. Incomplete appeal requests will be denied.
- It is the student's responsibility to submit their appeal by the published deadline. Late appeals requests will be denied.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- This appeal refers to what credits you are currently enrolled in for the 2025-26 academic year.
- Appeals must be filed per term if you are enrolled in less than 12 credits each term.
- Students who received a Part-Time Grant from MHEC in the 2025-26 school year cannot file an Enrolled in Less Than 12 Credits appeal.

For approved appeals, GA and EA Grants are recalculated based on part-time status:

- A student enrolled in 9-11 credits will receive three-quarters of the award
- A student enrolled in 6-8 credits will receive one-half of the award
