The Delegate Howard P. Rawlings Educational Assistance (EA) Grant is a need-based grant that provides financial assistance to eligible Maryland undergraduate students enrolled at Maryland colleges and universities.

Award

The Educational Assistance Grant awards up to \$3,000 annually for up to 4 years.

How to Apply

- Complete and file the 2026-2027 Free
 Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or
 MHEC One-App (for eligible undocumented
 students) by March 1, 2026 listing at least one
 Maryland college or university
- Create and activate an Maryland College Aid Processing System (MDCAPS) account
- Submit any requested documents (if required) by August 1, 2026

Eligibility

INITIAL

- File the FAFSA or MHEC One-App by March 1;
- Be eligible for in-state tuition in Maryland as Maryland resident
- Demonstrate financial need based on OSFA calculation;
- Be accepted for admission and plan to enroll in a regular undergraduate program at an eligible two-year or four-year Maryland institution as a full-time degree-seeking student.

RENEWAL

- File the FAFSA or MHEC One-App by March 1 each year;
- Be eligible for in-state tuition in Maryland as a Maryland resident
- Continue to demonstrate financial need based on OSFA calculation
- Continue enrollment in a regular undergraduate program at an eligible Maryland institution as a fulltime degree-seeking student;
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress (SAP);
- Meet the credit completion requirements beginning in the third year of receiving the award.

IMPORTANT: Students cannot receive both the Educational Assistance Grant and Guaranteed Access Grant at the same time.
