#### Introduction

This report contains the retention and graduation patterns of full-time undergraduate students at Maryland's public four-year colleges and universities from 1981 to 2001. Specifically, it looks at the number and percentage of students who were retained at their <u>original</u> public four-year campus and those who graduated from <u>any</u> senior public college or university in the State.<sup>1</sup>

The retention rate for the entering class of 1996 and beyond includes changes resulting from the development of the Federal Graduation Rate Survey (GRS) and from recommendations of an intersegmental workgroup appointed to advise the Commission on this subject. GRS is part of a federal initiative to collect data necessary to prepare reports required by the Student Right-to-Know Act of 1990. There are some differences between the calculations from previous years beginning with the 1996 cohort:

- Include retention rates of <u>all</u> first-time undergraduates and not just first-time freshmen.
- Students who are enrolled at multiple institutions are included more than once in the cohort. In the past, these cross-enrolled students were reported at only one campus on a randomly selected basis.
- If an institution reports a new social security number for a student, the student is now tracked on the basis of the new number. In the past, these students were treated as having dropped from the institution. The impact of this change will be greatest at institutions with a large number of foreign students, who are often assigned "dummy" social security numbers when they initially enroll.
- The method used to match student enrollment and degree attainment will be based on the federal GRS procedures and on the recommendations of the GRS workgroup.


Information on cohorts from previous years remains unchanged. There are no significant policy changes in Maryland's data resulting from GRS.

#### **Findings**


#### Second Year Retention Rates: Statewide

• The second-year retention rate of all full-time, first-time undergraduates, as measured by the percentage of those returning to their original campus after one year, was 82.6 percent for the 2001 cohort. This is the highest retention rate achieved since Maryland began collecting these statistics in the late 1970s.



- The second-year retention rate for African-American students was 74.9 percent for the second consecutive year and the lowest for this group since the 1991 cohort. The retention rate of African-American students trailed that of other students.
- While female students have always exceeded their male counterparts in second year retention since the Commission began collecting these figures, the gap has steadily narrowed since the 1991 cohort. The second-year retention rate of first-time full-time female students was 83 percent for the 2001 cohort compared to 82 percent for first-time full-time male students.

#### Six-Year Graduation Rate: Statewide


• The six-year graduation rate for the most recent cohort of all new full-time students is at **an all time high** at 59.3 percent. The six-year graduation rates for African-Americans and Hispanics are significantly below the rates for whites and Asians.

By Ethnic Background



• Although the six-year graduation rate for full-time African-American students has consistently lagged behind that of all students and other ethnic groups, this gap has narrowed since 1981 when only 26.1 percent of African-American students graduated. The graduation rate for African-American students reached an all time high at 45.1 in the most recent cohort.

African-American Students and All Students




• Women are more likely to graduate in six-years than men. The six-year graduation rate of female students for the entering class of 1996 reached 63.4 percent. In comparison, just 54.3 percent of male students in the 1996 cohort graduated in this period. Both of these figures represent historical highs. The six-year graduation rates of women have always exceeded that of men.



#### Second-Year Retention: By Institution

- The second year retention rate of the 2001 cohort at University of Maryland College Park (91.6 percent) and St. Mary's College of Maryland (90.4 percent) exceeded all other public four-year institutions.
- The second year retention rates of African-American students in the 2001 cohort were the highest at Towson, UMCP and UMBC. The rates of African-American students at Towson and UMBC surpassed the rates of students of all races at these campuses.



#### Six Year Graduation Rate: By Institution

- The four-year public institutions with the greatest six-year graduation rates for the entering class of 1996 were St. Mary's (84.0 percent), Salisbury (70.8 percent), UMCP (68.9 percent) and Towson (60.3 percent). Four institutions (Coppin, UMCP, UMES, and St. Mary's) experienced the highest six-year rate on record.
- The four-year public institutions that had the greatest six-year graduation rates among African-Americans in the 1996 cohort were St. Mary's (81.8 percent), UMBC (58.6 percent), College Park (56.6 percent), and Salisbury (54.1 percent). The rates at UMCP surged more than eight percentage points to the highest in the institution's history. The six-year graduation rate of African-Americans at UMBC was greater than that for whites.
