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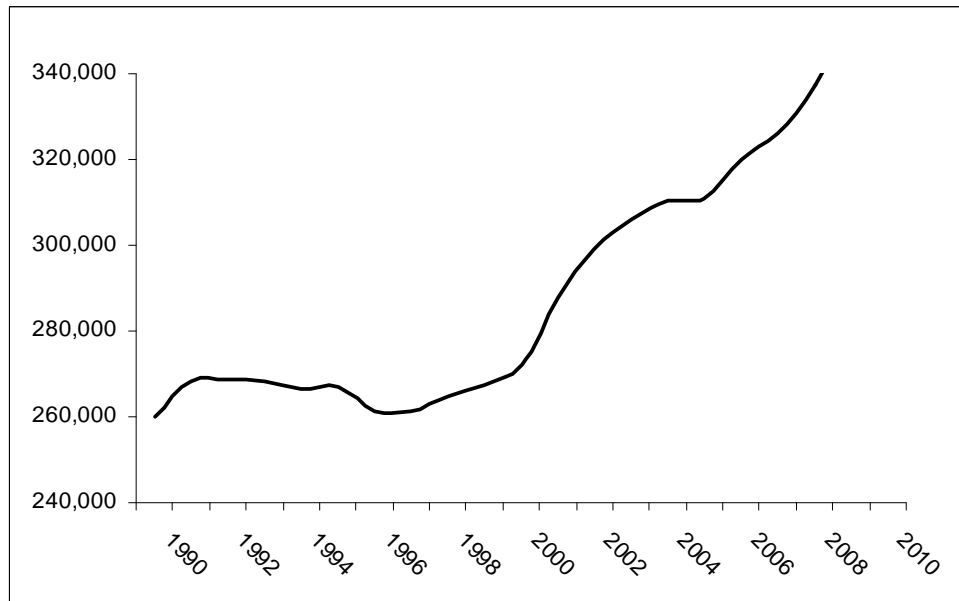
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Enrollments *Soar* at Maryland's Colleges and Universities

The following report highlights preliminary enrollment data submitted for fall 2010 by the State's colleges and universities. Final enrollment figures which are reported later in the term may vary slightly from those included in this report.

Opening Enrollment at Maryland Colleges and Universities, 1990 - 2010



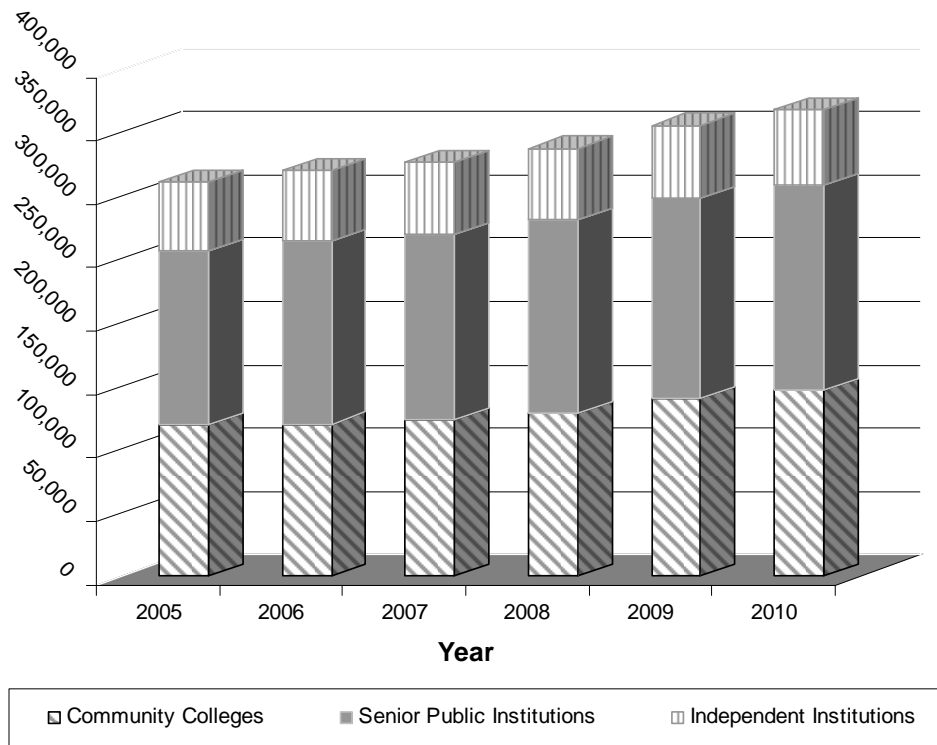
- **This year's headcount enrollments set a new record high for the State's postsecondary institutions.** Total headcount enrollment at Maryland's colleges and universities increased by 3.6 percent to 368,126 students, a gain of 12,818 students since last year.
- Over the last 20 years, total enrollment in Maryland's degree-granting postsecondary institutions has grown by nearly 42 percent, or over 100,000 students.
- Maryland's independent colleges and universities experienced the largest percentile gains of any higher education sector. Total enrollment at independent

institutions increased by 4.5 percent (2,573 students), and accounted for 20.1 percent of the State's enrollment growth. Last year, independent institutions were only responsible for 6.5 percent of total postsecondary enrollment gains. Enrollment at the community colleges increased 4.2 percent or 5,887 students. Last year, Maryland's community colleges experienced a significant spike in enrollment from 128,093 to 140,031 students, a 9.3 percent change from 2008 to 2009. Higher education research shows that during times of economic downturn, enrollments at community colleges soar.

This year, community college enrollments also accounted for nearly half (45.9 percent) of the year-to-year growth in postsecondary enrollments, whereas last year, the community colleges were responsible for more than two-thirds (67.7 percent) of the State's

enrollment growth. Compared to enrollment increases at the independent institutions and community colleges, growth at the public four-year campuses was more modest and totaled just 2.8 percent or 4,358 students. This year, the public four-year sector accounted for 34.0 percent of the State’s postsecondary enrollment growth, up from last year when it was responsible for just over one-quarter (25.8 percent) of all statewide enrollment increases.

- Total enrollment for the University System of Maryland increased by 2.6 percent (3,820 students) to 152,496, and enrollment at Morgan State University increased by 8.0 percent (579 students) to 7,805 students. Forty-one fewer students enrolled at St. Mary’s College of Maryland this year resulting in an enrollment decrease of 2.0 percent.
- Full-time undergraduate enrollment in the State’s colleges and universities increased by 2.6 percent to 169,263 students. Gains for this group were responsible for 32.9 percent of total (undergraduate and graduate) enrollment growth. Although full-time undergraduate enrollments increased in all postsecondary sectors, independent colleges and universities experienced the largest gains (7.1

percent) for this group. Since 1993, the number of full-time undergraduates enrolled in the State has steadily increased from 107,584 to 169,263 students (57.3 percent).

- The part-time undergraduate headcount increased by 5.7 percent since last year, growing by 6,856 students. Enrollment of part-time undergraduates at the State's community colleges increased by 6.3 percent (5,456 students), and at the University System of Maryland by 4.7 percent or 1,430 students. The State's independent colleges and universities experienced decreases in their part-time undergraduate enrollments by 3.5 percent.
- The number of full-time graduate students enrolled increased by 5.3 percent to 27,986 students, while part-time graduate students increased by less than one percent to 42,952. Overall, there were 70,938 graduate students enrolled at Maryland's colleges and universities, setting a new record high. Since 1990, graduate enrollment has increased by 77.1 percent, or over 30,000 students.
- All community colleges experienced overall enrollment gains except for Allegany College of Maryland (-32.7 percent, -1,334 students), Garrett College (-4.1 percent, -37 students) and Montgomery College (-0.5 percent, -132 students). For two consecutive years, enrollments at the Community College of Baltimore County increased by the largest *number* of students (2,841 this year and 2,911 last year), and also by the highest *percentage* of students (12.0 percent this year and 14.1 percent last year).
- Overall, first-time, full-time undergraduate enrollments decreased by 2.3 percent, from 41,246 in fall 2009 to 40,291 in fall 2010. This marks a change from last year's opening fall enrollment reports which cited an increase in the number of new full-time undergraduates enrolled at Maryland campuses. The number of first-time, full-time students attending the State's independent colleges and universities increased by 6.1 percent, while the number attending public four-year institutions (-3.0 percent), and community colleges (-5.7 percent) decreased substantially.
- Total enrollment (undergraduate and graduate combined) increased at 9 of the 13 public four-year colleges and universities. Enrollments at the University of Maryland University College increased by the largest *number* of students (2,145), and Morgan State University experienced the greatest percentage increase in enrollments (8.0 percent). Enrollments at Bowie State University, Coppin State University, the University of Maryland Baltimore and St. Mary's College of Maryland declined.
- Total headcount enrollments increased at 20 of the 30 independent colleges and universities, and remained the same at Fortis College. Lincoln College of Technology had the largest numerical increase (633 students), and experienced the greatest percentage increase (107.3 percent) in enrollments.
- Women continue to outnumber men in all sectors of Maryland's colleges and universities, and represent 57.4 percent of all students enrolled. However, enrollment increases for men once again out paced increases for women (5.4 percent vs. 2.3 percent).
