STATE ORCHESTRATED TRANSFER AGREEMENT UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE and MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION

In order to serve the students impacted by the precipitous closure of ITT Educational Services, Inc. ("ITT"), which had locations in Hanover, Maryland, Owings Mills, Maryland, and elsewhere in the United States, the University of Maryland University College ("UMUC") has entered into this State Orchestrated Transfer Agreement ("Agreement") with the Maryland Higher Education Commission ("MHEC").

A. Qualifying ITT Students

This Agreement pertains only to the transfer of "Qualifying Students", i.e., those students who:

- 1. were enrolled in an ITT program between July 1, 2015 and September 6, 2016;
- 2. have not been enrolled in an institution of higher education since being enrolled at ITT;
- 3. were not subject to disciplinary action at ITT;
- 4. with respect to students who completed less than 36 quarter credits at ITT, submit official proof of high school graduation or equivalent; and
- 5. had a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher at ITT.

B. Duties of UMUC

UMUC agrees to implement the transfer of Qualifying Students in accordance with the following requirements and protocols:

- 1. A Qualifying Student may transfer into a comparable program that UMUC is approved by MHEC to offer. ITT operated on a quarter structure and UMUC operates on a semester structure; so 1:1 credit transfer is not possible. UMUC will award transfer credit following the course-by-course mapping set forth in Paragraphs 2 and 3, below. Any course for which the student received credit, dual credit and/or credit for prior learning from ITT that does not appear in Paragraphs 2 and 3, below, will be reviewed on an individual basis to determine transferability to UMUC.
- 2. Comparable programs that UMUC is willing to accept credit for include: See Appendix A
- 3. Comparable courses that UMUC is willing to transfer credits for include: See Appendix B
- 4. The application fee for Qualifying Students shall be waived by UMUC. All Qualifying Students who enroll at UMUC shall be offered tuition equivalent to UMUC's in-state rate. - 5. If additional books, materials, or industry test exams are required to complete the program, the Qualifying Student shall be given the choice of purchasing these through UMUC, if available, or through other sources.
- 6. Qualifying Students can enroll in any program offered at UMUC, but the number of transfer credits may not be optimal if they choose an unaligned program.
- 7. UMUC shall designate, and shall provide to MHEC the contact information for, a staff person at UMUC who is responsible for the oversight of the transfer of Qualifying Students.
- 8. If the Qualifying Student is using federal Title 38 VA Education Benefits (GI Bill® Education Benefits), UMUC shall adhere to all applicable U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs' regulations, including the regulations governing the awarding prior credit, as regulated under Title 38, Code of Federal Regulations, Sections 21.4253(d)(3) and 21.4254(c)(4).
- 9. UMUC shall enroll a Qualifying Student who is using Title 38 VA Education Benefits (GI Bill® Education Benefits) only in a VA-qualified program or educational institution.
- 10. Regarding GI Benefits, UMUC understands that courses that were successfully completed by the Qualifying Student at ITT generally may not be certified again for VA purposes if the courses are repeated. However, if a student failed a course, or if a program requires a higher grade than the one achieved in a particular course for successful completion, then UMUC may be able to re-certify the course in accordance with applicable federal regulations.
- 11. A Qualifying Student may enroll in an onsite or online program at UMUC.
- 12. ITT students may be eligible to have federal student loans discharged. Updated information about how to receive a discharge can be found at https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/about/announcements/itt
- 13. ITT students applying to UMUC are required to sign an acknowledgment that the student has been provided with information regarding the U.S. Department of Education's loan discharge policy by UMUC. UMUC will not advise ITT students regarding whether the student is eligible for loan discharge.
- 14. ITT students will follow the standard UMUC process for financial aid and scholarships.
- 15. ITT students that do not meet the definition of Qualifying Students may apply under UMUC's standard admissions process.
- 16. If UMUC discovers after a student has been admitted under this agreement that fraudulent

information or documentation was used in the admissions process, the student will be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with UMUC's <u>Code of Student Conduct</u>. In such instances, UMUC may immediately terminate the student's eligibility to continue under this agreement and the student will be assessed the standard application fees and tuition fees based on the student's residency status retroactively and will be charged standard tuition fees for the remainder of the student's enrollment at UMUC.

C. Duties of Maryland Higher Education Commission

- 1. MHEC shall provide to UMUC the contact information of MHEC staff members who are coordinating the transfer options for ITT students, including the contact information of a staff person from whom to obtain Qualifying Students' transcripts.
- 2. MHEC shall provide to Qualifying Students information concerning the transfer opportunity with UMUC.

D. Termination

- 1. MHEC or UMUC may, at its sole discretion, terminate this Agreement upon delivering 30 days written notice to the other party.
- 2. Upon any termination, Sections B, G, and I shall survive the termination of this Agreement and remain in full force and effect.

E. Amendment

- 1. This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding of MHEC <u>and UMUC</u> with respect to their rights and obligations in carrying out the terms of the Agreement, and supersedes any prior or contemporaneous agreements or understandings.
- 2. This Agreement may be modified only by written amendment executed by both parties.

F. Term of Agreement

This Agreement is for a term commencing on the date that this Agreement has been executed by both parties (the "Effective Date"), and shall terminate upon: (1) either party delivering notice to the other pursuant to the terms of Section D of this Agreement; or (2) the program completion of all Qualifying Students at UMUC.

G. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Maryland.

H. Counterparts.

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, but all of which, taken together, shall constitute one and the same agreement.

I. Representations and Warranties of the Parties

Both parties to this Agreement represent and warrant that the following shall be true and correct as of the Effective Date of this Agreement, and shall continue to be true and correct during the Term of this Agreement:

- 1. The parties are and shall remain in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local statutes, laws, ordinances, and regulations relating to this Agreement, as amended from time to time.
- 2. Each party has taken all action necessary for the approval and execution of this Agreement, and execution by the persons signing on behalf of each party is duly authorized and has been made with complete and full authority to commit the party to all terms and conditions of this Agreement, which shall constitute valid, binding obligations of each party.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this Agreement to be executed by their duly authorized representatives.
