

CAREER / OCCUPATIONAL

CHARLES W. RILEY FIREFIGHTER & AMBULANCE & RESCUE SQUAD MEMBER SCHOLARSHIP

Must complete the application in MDCAPS by May 1

Award Amount - Varies

Only actively engaged career or volunteer firefighters and EMT workers in Maryland may apply

JANET L. HOFFMAN LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM

Must complete a LARP General application

Award Amount - Varies

Provides assistance for repayment of loan debt to select individuals employed in nonprofit *organizations that provide public service to underserved residents*

MARYLAND POLICE OFFICER SCHOLARSHIP

Must complete the application in MDCAPS

Award Amount - Varies

Provides assistance to police officers or individuals planning to become a police officer

MDC-LARP (Dentist)

Must complete the application in MDCAPS

Award Amount - up to \$23,740

Provides assistance for repayment of loan debt to dentists

MARYLAND POLICE OFFICER LARP

Must complete the application in MDCAPS

Award Amount - Varies

Eligible Maryland police officers may receive assistance in repayment of a higher education loan

RICHARD W. COLLINS III LEADERSHIP WITH HONOR SCHOLARSHIP

Must complete the FAFSA/MSFAA
Complete application available in MDCAPS
Submit all documentation by deadline

Award Amount - Varies

A ROTC member who is a minority student or a student of another group historically underrepresented. Students must be enrolled full time at one of the following institutions: Bowie State University, Coppin State University, Morgan State University, or University of Maryland Eastern Shore

CYBERSECURITY PUBLIC SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

Complete the application available in MDCAPS by July 1
Submit all documentation by deadline

Award Amount - Varies

Enrolled full-time or part-time at a public or a private nonprofit institution in the state in an approved credit-bearing degree or an approved credit-bearing certificate program

TEACHING FELLOWS SCHOLARSHIP

Complete the application available in MDCAPS
Submit all documentation by deadline

Award Amount - Varies

Enroll or plan to enroll at an eligible institution as an undergraduate or graduate student or seek to change careers to pursue a course of study or program in an academic discipline leading to a Maryland professional teacher's certificate

NEAR COMPLETER GRANT

Contact the previous college or university you attended
Award Amount - Varies

Attended a two-year or four-year institution and completed college credits but does not have a college degree and is no longer attending an institution of higher education.

Completed 45 credits (two-year) or 90 credits (four-year)

Minimum GPA 2.0

All careers and occupations are eligible

NEED BASED

MARYLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP (MCCPS)

Must complete the FAFSA/MSFAA by March 1st
Award Amount - up to \$5,000
Students must submit ALL documentation if required

GUARANTEED ACCESS GRANT

Must complete the FAFSA/MSFAA by March 1st
Must complete additional applications in MDCAPS
Award Amount - up to \$20,000
Open to high school seniors who enroll full time at a Maryland two-year or four-year college or university

EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE GRANT

Must complete the FAFSA/MSFAA by March 1st
Award Amount - up to \$3,000
Open to new and current undergraduates who will enroll full time at a Maryland two-year or four-year college or university

PART-TIME GRANT

Must complete the FAFSA/MSFAA
Award Amount - up to \$2,000
Must be a part-time, degree-seeking undergraduate student or a dually enrolled student at an eligible Maryland institution

2 + 2 TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP

Must complete the FAFSA by March 1st
Award Amount - up to \$2,000
Open to current undergraduate students at a Maryland community college who will graduate with an associate degree and are accepted for admission in a degree program at a Maryland public or private college or university

GRADUATE & PROFESSIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

Must complete the FAFSA & institutional application
Award Amount - up to \$5,000

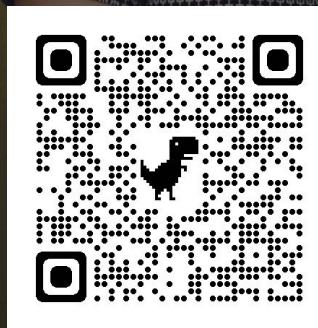
Must complete the FAFSA/MSFAA and contact your local Maryland delegate(s) to apply
Award Amount - Varies
Open to full-time and part-time students

Open to full-time and part-time students

JACK F. TOLBERT MEMORIAL STUDENT GRANT

Must complete the FAFSA
Award Amount - up to \$500
Contact the Private Career School's Financial Aid Office

EDWARD T. CONROY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Must contact Institution's Financial Aid Office
Award Amount - May not exceed annual tuition & mandatory fees
Provides assistance to 100% disabled public service employees, children & spouses of deceased and 100% disabled military and spouses and children of victims of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks

JEAN B. CRYOR SCHOLARSHIP

Must contact Institution's Financial Aid Office
Provides assistance to 100% disabled employees of a public or nonpublic school in the state, children, stepchildren & spouses of deceased and 100% disabled employees of a public or nonpublic school in the state and spouses, children & stepchildren of victims of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks

VETERANS OF THE AFGHANISTAN AND IRAQ CONFLICTS SCHOLARSHIP

Must complete the application in MDCAPS
Award Amount - up to \$7,735
Veterans who served in the Afghanistan or Iraq Conflicts and their spouse, son, daughter, stepson, or stepdaughter, and is a full-time or part-time, degree-seeking undergraduate student enrolled in an eligible accredited Maryland postsecondary institution. FAFSA and the application due by March 1st

TUITION WAIVER FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Must complete FAFSA
Award Amount - Varies
Tuition Waiver for students receiving Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) benefits

TUITION WAIVER FOR UNACCOMPANIED HOMELESS YOUTH

Must complete the FAFSA
Award Amount - Varies
Provides assistance for unaccompanied homeless youth in Maryland at the time of high school graduation or completion of a GED

TUITION WAIVER FOR FOSTER CARE STUDENTS

Must complete the FAFSA & fulfill requirements from the Maryland Department of Human Services
Award Amount - Varies
Provides assistance for out-of-home placed students in Maryland at the time of high school graduation or completion of a GED
